The eSTATS section of the Achieving the Dream Web site has been updated with 2005 cohort data for all colleges and updated longitudinal data from previous cohorts if applicable (Round 1 & Round 2 Colleges). The eSTATS tool allows colleges to analyze their own student performance in developmental courses and progress to credit bearing courses, student persistence, and enrollment & successful completion of gatekeeper courses.
