Program Description:

This program includes an introduction to anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, wound control, splinting, and moving patients. This course is required of all ambulance service personnel prior to employment and serves as a prerequisite to the EMT-Intermediate and Paramedic courses.

Number of Faculty:

The Emergency Medical Technology Program currently has one faculty member.

Maximum Student Enrollment per semester:

The Emergency Medical Technology program has a maximum enrollment of 15 students.

Program Duration/ Certificates and Degrees:

The Emergency Medical Technology program is a one semester certificate program requiring 7 credit hours upon completion. After completion of the certificate program, a student can continue on into the Emergency Medical Services/Paramedic A.A.S. program.
