The Nursing Division offers a certificate program designed to prepare the student for employment in the healthcare field. The certificate program is a 12 month full time or 24 month part time program that, when completed, enables the individual to apply for licensure and to write the National Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (LPN). It is important to note that completion of the certificate program in nursing does not guarantee a graduate the right to take the national exam. The State Board of Nursing makes the decision regarding eligibility to apply for licensure and testing. Students must be accepted into the Nursing program before enrolling in any Nursing Program courses.
